We offer two levels of service, depending on the buyer's requirements:

1. Sample Testing Quality Control

Overview:

We randomly select samples from approximately 30% of a lot, mix them, and evaluate to provide a representative overview of the coffee quality.

Included Services:

- Two professional Quality Control Specialists on site (minimum two to ensure full transparency, prevent errors, and maintain objectivity).
- Inspection Duration: 2 days on-site, including travel time
- Transportation: Toyota Hilux vehicle with driver and fuel, specifically chosen for access to remote coffee-producing regions and difficult terrain.
- Accommodation & Meals: Provided for the specialists, including allowances as required under Angolan labor regulations for work conducted in provincial areas (Law No. 7/15 of 15 June 2015)
- Final Report Preparation: Detailed documentation, analysis, and presentation of findings.

Final Report Covers:

- Physical Characteristics Assessment: Moisture content, screen size, and bean density.
- Defects Analysis: Classification of primary and secondary defects with clear specifications and percentage distribution.
- Quantity Verification: Verification of total bean volume, number of bags, and consistency across the lot.
- Documentation: Completed reporting forms, including comprehensive photo and video evidence of the inspected coffee.

2. Bag-by-Bag Quality Control

Overview:

This is a comprehensive inspection covering every single bag in a lot (typically 320 bags per 20' container, totaling 19,200 kg). The Bag-by-Bag inspection provides the highest level of accuracy and transparency, ensuring that the quality and condition of all coffee beans are thoroughly evaluated.

Benefits of Bag-by-Bag Inspection:

- Ensures complete visibility and control over the entire shipment.
- Minimizes the risk of undiscovered quality issues.
- Provides reliable documentation for buyer confidence and compliance with international quality standards.
- Allows informed decisions regarding storage, shipment, or blending based on accurate and detailed data.
